I. President's report

A. Review of new maps after Redistricting

1. Congressional

- a) Most of Long Beach, Lakewood, and Downey are in one congressional map. North Long Beach, Carson, Lynwood, Huntington Park, South Gate, and the port are included in the other map that includes Long Beach.
- b) Noted that California's 40th congressional district will be dissolved (currently represented by Lucille Roybal-allard) due to CA losing one seat as a result of the 2020 Census.

2. State Senate

- a) CA Sen-33 will include most of Long Beach, and CA Sen-34 will include the eastern portion of the city near Los Alamitos and Sunset Beach.

3. State Assembly

- a) Long Beach will now be contained by only one assembly district, while losing the portion of San Pedro previously included.

4. City Council

a) District updates

- (1) D1 Brought further north, lost Westside
- (2) D7 now includes all of Westside and some of the port
- (3) D6 now includes all of Cambodia Town
- (4) D2 is smaller and includes less waterfront
- (5) D9 remains relatively unchanged
- (6) D8 slightly condensed
- (7) D5 gained the rest of Cal Heights
- (8) D3 and D4 no longer intertwine and are divided along PCH and 7th past Bellflower.
- (9) D4 now includes all of CSULB student population.

- b) Cindy Allen and Stacy Mungo no longer live in their respective districts

- (1) Allen now resides in D1 and Mungo now lives in D4
